Optimum time is based on 435 m /minute

RULES:

1. CRASH HATS: must be worn with chin strap fastened at all times when mounted. Hats must comply with the BE Hat rules. And be suitably tagged
2. Body protector must be worn for the jumping classes.
3. There will be an optimum time for all jumping classes and placings are decided on a "nearest the optimum time" basis
4. Entries are limited and taken in order of receipt.
5. Any objections must be made within 15 minutes of completion of the class and accompanied by a deposit of £20.
6. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes if there are insufficient entries.
7. Entry fees will be refunded if withdrawals are made before the close of entries, thereafter only if the place is taken up by another competitor.
8. Horses / Ponies must be 4 years old or over.
9. Withdrawals must be made before the closing date for refunds to be issued.
